

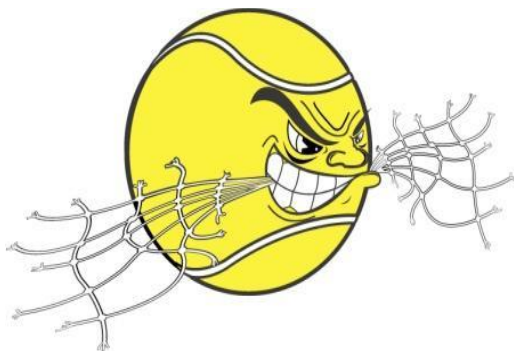


## Directions

### Glens Falls Tennis & Swim Club

Exit 19 of the Northway (I87). Right at the end of the ramp (Aviation Road). Right onto East Sanford - approx. 3 miles. The club is approx. 200 yards in - use the second club turnoff (the first is the exit).

(518) 792-5512. **NOTE:** Aviation Road becomes Quaker after crossing Route 9; stay on Aviation/Quaker.

### QUESTIONS THE COACH MAY ASK YOU

*What is your biggest win?*

*What makes you a good team player?*

*How many tournaments do you plan on playing this year?*

*How often do you play doubles?*



## The Coaches

### **Gary Glassman – SUNY Stony Brook**

Gary has coached both the Men's and Women's teams at SUNY Stony Brook for the past 11 seasons. His combined record is 251-141. His team has been ranked as high as 70. Gary was recently a member of the NCAA Division 1 Tennis Committee and Intercollegiate Athletic Association (ITA) regional ranking committee. Gary was the ITA Northeast Region Men's Coach of the Year in 2004. His teams have earned a total of 53 ITA All-Academic Team awards. Before coaching at Stony Brook, Gary coached at Georgia Southern where he earned Southern Conference Coach of the Year and his team was ranked as high as 45 in the country (D1). Gary played his college tennis at Oneonta where he still ranks in the top 10 for career wins.

### **Tim Smith – Marist College**

Tim is in the middle of his thirteenth season as Head Men's Tennis Coach. For his first twelve years Tim's overall record is 204-67 (72-5 in the MAAC Conference). Tim was USPTA Coach of the Year - Eastern Section in 1993, 1995 and 2009. He has brought his team to the NCAA's 6 times. Tim previously coached at Dutchess Community College where his teams twice finished in the top 10 nationally (NJCAA). In 2008 he was inducted into the Dutchess County Sports Museum Hall of Fame.

### **Nathan Simms – Skidmore College**

Nathan Simms took over the Skidmore program in 2006 after spending the previous six years as head women's coach at Middlebury College, compiling a 75-29 record. Under his direction, the Panthers consistently ranked in the national top-20 and earned four trips to the NCAA Division III Tournament. The 2005 team advanced to the NCAA semifinals, earning Simms ITA Northeast and New England Small College Athletic Conference Coach of the Year awards.

This summer we will have junior and adult lesson programs for everyone from the beginners to tournament players.
